- The appropriate entry fees must be paid by cheque payable to 'The Darlington Farmers Auction Mart' or by BACS to The Darlington Farmers Auction Mart a/c 31734668 sort 30-84-43
- · No entry will be valid without the appropriate payment
- Entry Fees Cattle £20 plus VAT (£24) per entry
- Entry Fees Sheep £10 plus VAT (£12) per entry
- A maximum of 2 entries in any one class are permitted by any one exhibitor
- All livestock must be identified and be moved within current Defra regulations
- No animal/s may be entered in more than one class.

- Cattle Exhibitors must state if their cattle are from a high-risk TB area on the entry form, those requiring a pre-movement TB test must bring with them a current TB test certificate
- Cattle All cattle must be accompanied by their official passport, entry will be refused without
- All sheep must be accompanied by a current DEFRA sheep licence
- Sheep There will be no MV accredited section in place
- Sheep No entire tup lambs will be accepted, ewe lambs must be empty

- Sheep Entries in the un-trimmed classes may have their tales 'squared off' however no further dressing will be permitted
- All exhibitors are responsible for the accuracy of their entry form, any dispute will be dealt with by the organisers, their decision will be final
- Cattle All cattle must be halter led in the judging rings by a competent person; no cattle handler can be under 14 years old at the time of the show
- Sheep All sheep handlers must be competent and have the physical ability to control their sheep at all times; no sheep handler can be under 8 years old at the time of the show
- The event organisers reserve the right to disqualify any entry deemed to have broken the show rules, in the event that this entry is a prize-winner the other entries in its class will be promoted
- All entries must be the sole property of the exhibitor/s at the time of entry with the exception of class 17
