**LOCATION:** Darlington Farmers Auction Mart, T: 01325 464529 Humbleton Park, Darlington, E: info@dfam.co.uk Durham, DL2 2XX <u>www.dfam.co.uk</u> **METHOD OF SALE:** All pedigree cattle will be sold in guineas (105 pence) and strictly in catalogue order, unless any alteration is announced by the Auctioneers.

Commercial Cattle will be sold in £'s per head.

**COMMISSIONS:** The Auctioneers will dutifully execute commission bids to purchase for buyers unable to attend the sale personally, upon the receipt of written instructions. Any cattle sold outside of the sale ring must be booked through the office, full commission will be charged.

DFAM will charge a 5p in the Guinea Commission to the vendor on all pedigree cattle. DFAM will charge 4% commission on all the commercial cattle. No commission will be charged to the buyer.

**LEVIES**: The Beef Shorthorn Society will receive a 1% levy on all pedigree cattle sold. No society or other levies apply to the commercial cattle sold.

**SETTLEMENT AND CLEARANCE OF STOCK:** Settlement in full is due immediately at the close of the Sale. No animal may leave the Sale Premises without an official 'Pass Slip', obtainable only from the Auctioneers upon settlement. Purchasers unable to remove their stock on the day of sale may be able to pre-arrange overnight accommodation with the Auctioneers on the understanding that all cattle are left at the Purchasers' risk.

**REGISTRATIONS:** All Pedigree stock in the sale are registered with The Beef Shorthorn Cattle Society, Society Pavilion, Avenue M, Stoneleigh Park, Kenilworth, Warwickshire CV8 2RG

**PEDIGREE TRANSFERS:** Any purchaser wishing transfer of ownership must notify The Beef Shorthorn Cattle Society.

**VETERINARY INSPECTION:** No inspections will be carried out at this sale. HERD HEALTH: As stated, declared by the Vendor in this catalogue or from the rostrum. ANY ANIMAL NOT IN POSSESSION OF THE REQUIRED DOCUMENTS WILL NOT BE OFFERED FOR SALE WITHOUT THEIR RESPECTIVE PASSPORT DOCUMENTATION

#### **IMPORTANT NOTICE TO VENDORS & PURCHASERS**

**UK TAGS:** All cattle entered for the Sale will have their UK Tags examined as an integral part of the pre-sale inspection procedure. The Sale will be held subject to the Auction Rules, Conditions of Sale. The proceeds of Sale are guaranteed by the Auctioneers, who will account to Vendors. Such guarantee however, does not extend to the animals sold for export, to which special conditions apply.

**ANIMAL WELFARE:** Vendors and Purchasers should note the CODE OF PRACTICE published by the Livestock Auctioneers' Market Committee for England and Wales IS OPERATIVE and that weak, unhealthy or injured stock will be refused entry by the Auctioneers. Enquiries should be directed through the market office to the Auctioneers' ANIMAL HEALTH & WELFARE OFFICER.

#### **CATTLE HEALTH**

Vendors are encouraged to apply to their respective CHeCS health scheme for individual animal health cards for display on pens. For an individual animal's test results, or vaccination histories, regarding BVD, IBR, Lepto or Johne's, these are permitted above the sale pens only upon presentation of a signed veterinary declaration to verify that the animal concerned has had a clear test. Again, for reasons of practicality, no health information notes are to be put in the catalogue footnotes by vendors. Again, the sole purpose of this is to avoid confusion and to try and ensure that the information provided is done accurately, fairly and in a standardised format in the catalogue. This point has been agreed with the auctioneers. Johne's Risk Levels The Health Declaration includes a section where breeders are able to indicate their Johne's Risk Level, once known. The Risk Levels are as follows:

Risk Level 1 herds that were previously Accredited

Risk Level 2 herds that have had 1 or more clear qualifying tests

Risk Level 3 herds that have 3% or fewer reactors every year\*

Risk Level 4 herds that have more than 3% reactors every year\*\*

Risk Level 5 herds not in a CHeCS Johne's disease programme, herds with no health plan in place and herds that are not carrying out the required testing

- \* Note, for herds with fewer than 33 animals in the target age range, rather than 3%, Risk Level 3 will be one animal testing positive for Johne's
- \*\* Note, for herds with fewer than 33 animals in the target age range, rather than 3%, Risk Level 4 will be more than one animal testing positive for Johne's
