


- All cattle and sheep to arrive between 12 noon and 4pm on Friday 3rd October 2025.
- All stock must be weighed. Weighing of stock will be held between 1pm and 4pm on Friday 3rd October 2025.
- All entry forms must be returned no later than 30th August 2025 to North East Live, DFAM, Humbleton Park, Darlington, DL2 2XX or emailed to Stephen@dfam.co.uk
- The appropriate entry fees must be paid by cheque payable to 'The Darlington Farmers Auction Mart' or by BACS to The Darlington Farmers Auction Mart a/c 31729068 sort 30-84-43
- No entry will be valid without the appropriate payment
- Entry Fees Cattle £20 plus VAT (£24) per entry
- Entry Fees Sheep £10 plus VAT (£12) per entry
- A maximum of 2 entries in any one class are permitted by any one exhibitor
- · All livestock must be identified and be moved within current Defra regulations
- No animal/s may be entered in more than one class
- Exhibitors will be allocated entry tickets ahead of the show
- All sheep, baby beef and pedigree cattle entries must have been born in the year of the show
- Cattle Exhibitors must state if their cattle are from a high-risk TB area on the entry form, those requiring a pre-movement TB test must bring with them a current TB test certificate

SATURDAY 4TH OCTOBER 2025

- Cattle All cattle must be accompanied by their official passport, entry will be refused without
- All sheep must be accompanied by a current DEFRA sheep licence
- Sheep There will be no MV accredited section in place
- Sheep No entire tup lambs will be accepted, ewe lambs must be empty
- Sheep Entries in the un-trimmed classes may have their tales 'squared off' however no further dressing will be permitted
- All exhibitors are responsible for the accuracy of their entry form, any dispute will be dealt with by the organisers, their decision will be final
- Cattle All cattle must be halter led in the judging rings by a competent person.
- Sheep All sheep handlers must be competent and have the physical ability to control their sheep at all times.
- Cattle If any animal entered in the baby beef classes are over the weight limit
 of 400kg they will be moved in to the appropriate breed class.
- Cattle No animal will be moved in to the baby beef class regardless of weight if it is not entered in the Baby Beef originally. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure their animals are entered in the correct class.
- Disclaimer In the absence of any negligence or other breach of duty by us,
 North East Live and its officers shall not be responsible for any accident,
 damage or loss howsoever caused that may occur to any exhibitor or his
 servant or to any animal, article or property exhibited or brought on to the
 show by him." Each exhibitor shall indemnify North East Live from and against
 all actions, suits, expenses or claims on account of or in respect of any such
 damage or injury however caused.
- Insurance By completing the entry form you indemnify North East Live that on or from the date of application up to and including the end of the show the applicant will hold valid insurance to insure against loss or damage caused to any person or property to a minimum value of £2 million.

- Space will be allocated for livestock exhibitor parking & camping; caravans/tents are welcomed for exhibitors only
- Please can we remind all exhibitors that this is a public event and that
 everyone involved has a duty to promote agriculture in a positive light. We
 encourage good sportsmanship and positive interaction with spectators;
 neither aggressive or unsportsmanlike behaviour will be tolerated in any
 way, shape or form
