Luing Cows on the Hill at Rudland Farm 28/01/2026

Foreword by Stephen Dodsworth, DFAM

The dispersal of the Sim-Luing cows from Rudland Farm provides a unique opportunity to acquire some genuine hill bred females which carry the ideal genetics, frame and scope to aid any commercial beef farming enterprise; these cattle are sold through absolutely no fault and are only offered due to a change in farming policy.

Rudland Farm lies in Bransdale and runs to over 1300 feet above sea level, this is an area synonymous with high-quality livestock production despite its justified reputation as one of the harshest environments on the North Yorkshire Moors. Rudland has been in the ownership of the Watson family for generations, for the past ten years the farming enterprise has been in the capable hands of the Myers family; a real team effort, at the helm the eldest son Sam, aided by parents (and neighbouring farmers) Robert and Julie along with brother Dan the family have developed this excellent herd of cows from the ground up.

The foundation pure-bred Luing cows run outdoors all year on the exposed Rudland Rigg; the Luing makes full use of less favoured hill ground which they share with the Myers renowned flock of Swaledale ewes. Top quality Simmental bulls are sourced to produce the Sim-Luing's which we see before us at this exciting sale. The current Simmental bull has proved to be a successful addition, hailing from Martin Farrar's Mossgrove pedigree herd.

The Sim-Luing cows and heifers in this sale are all scanned in calf to two excellent Limousin bulls, one from the Lisset herd of JH Tennant Ltd and the other from the Faddell herd of the late David Windress.

The cattle are from a TB4 area, the last test was approximately 12 months ago when everything on the farm went clear. The cows are not in a health scheme however have undergone routine Johnes tests twice in the past six years with no problems found. This is essentially a closed herd with the only notable interaction coming from the occasional stock bull purchase; the cows are not BVD tested however buyers can have the confidence that there has never been a problem during the Myers time on Rudland. The cattle were all PD'd in calf in December 2025 and the dates listed on the catalogue are the resulting stage of pregnancy at the point of sale.

On behalf of DfAM I would like thank the Myers family for the instruction to conduct this sale, I know the Bransdale area very well and with that knowledge understand its often unforgiving nature, I would urge anyone to bid with confidence. These are a clean, healthy and genuine herd which will go on and thrive anywhere they go. The high-quality Mule gimmer lambs produced annually along with the excellent pedigree Bluefaced Leicester and Swaledale sheep from the Myers are testament to the family's dedication and expert stockmanship within the industry. The herd of cows at Rudland have twice won the local NFU herd competition, an achievement not to be underestimated given the competition from the fertile lands of the Ryedale area.
